Friends -

First I want to give a big thank you to the faithful crew of people who have helped with the renovation and rebirth of our Christian Spiritual Formation spaces. We had crews of people who came and sorted materials. We had crews that cleaned and scrubbed walls and tables and rooms in The Core. If you have not had a chance to see their good work, TEACHERS - These men I strongly encourage you to check out the storage room in The Core, the elevator lobby on the third floor and the kitchen and classrooms in the Core. They did some heavy lifting to get the spaces prepared for renovation.


Second, I want to heartily thank those people who came in and painted the third floor classrooms. I know many of you wondered why I chose those intense colors. I hope that once you see the final products you will understand! We are creating fun and creative spaces for kids to engage with Sunday school and other faith formation activities. As I write this, each room is in a different state of completeness. Maybe by the time you read this, they will all be done. Either way, I invite you to come upstairs and explore.

We have a space themed room where kids will explore their understanding of God with science and technology. We have an ocean themed room where kids will use arts and crafts to engage their interests in the Creator. We have a forest themed room where kids will participate in stories using video, drama, books and oral history. We have a desert themed room where kids will use their bodies to engage in large-motor activities, and larger group gatherings. We have a jungle themed room that will be flexible and used for music another occasional methods of learning. Lastly, we have cleaned and renovated the nursery.

A lot of work has gone into making this possible. A lot of work is still to be done before we can fully launch our new children's and youth's faith formation programs. ASSISTANT TEACHERS - These men and women will work as often as they like. We need at least one assistant teacher per week to meet the safety requirements of supervision. Your job will be to help the teacher, to keep an eye on the students, to be enthusiastic and positive so the students will more fully engage.

AIDES - These youth, men or women will be assigned to a specific child or children who may be struggling. You will work one-to-one with kids to help them stay focused. This position is on an as-needed basis.

SUPPORT STAFF - These men and women will be behind the scenes workers. They won't necessarily have to work on Sunday mornings. They will periodically check on the storage rooms and cabinets to make sure we are adequately stocked and properly organized. They will note when things need replacement or repair and notify me.
